What can you expect from this Programme?

Leadership Cayman challenges you to look at the problems and decision-making processes in our community.

Interaction among class members and face-to-face contact with community leaders stimulates creative thinking and helps identify ways you can become more involved in our community.

Who is eligible to Apply?

Applicants should have resided in the Cayman Islands for at least one year, be at least 25 years of age by January 1, 2020, & should be in at least a middle management position or higher.

Information Sessions

All applicants are strongly encouraged to attend one of the 45-minute orientation sessions beginning at 5:30 p.m. to learn more about the programme:

- Wednesday, June 18, 2019
- Tuesday, July 16, 2019

Location (unless otherwise noted): Chamber of Commerce, Governors Square.

What is the Selection Process?

Initial screening is based on this application. All applications are due by Wednesday, July 31, 2019, with the application fee of CI\$75 and a copy of the applicant’s passport. The first page of the application, which identifies the applicant, is removed before Leadership Cayman Planning Committee members evaluate the applications. Next, applicants are selected for personal interviews with the Planning Committee at one of the following sessions.

- Wednesday, August 21, 2019, 5:00 – 9:00 pm
- Thursday, August 22, 2019, 5:00 – 9:00 pm
- Tuesday, August 27, 2019, 5:00 – 9:00 pm

A class of 24 individuals maximum will be selected. Since more applications are received than class size permits, some qualified applicants may not be chosen for this particular class. We encourage these individuals to apply for next year’s class.

What are the Requirements?

In order to graduate participants must attend the Opening Retreat and at least 9 of the 11 seminars. Each class participant will moderate a seminar with other class members and take part in the class community project. Class tuition, while valued at over \$4,000, is subsidised in large part by the generous sponsorships of local organisations. The all-inclusive fee for Chamber members is CI\$2,250 and for future-members is CI\$2,500 (the \$250 difference can be used as a credit towards Chamber membership). Fees are due by September 13, 2019.
